1. Introduction

1.1 These conditions govern the use of the website www.bazista.io, the only authorised Bazista platform website to purchase BZS tokens during ICO.

1.2 These conditions constitute an agreement between Osäühing Digital Payment Solutions, a private company established under the laws of the Republic of Estonia (Company registration number: 14298836, Address: Narva mnt 63/4, Kesklinna district, Tallinn city, Harju countru, Estonia, 10152). Digital Payment Solutions is not a financial institution and does not give investment advice or any other licensed financial services.

1.3 Currently, technical and organisational features of the Bazista trading platform are in the developmental stage, and their implementation will be financed using resources obtained during ICO.

1.4 Users cannot participate in ICO if the laws of their home country impose appropriate legal restrictions on such transactions. Liability for knowledge of the laws in terms of participating in ICO shall be imposed on participants in the primary depositing of BZS tokens.

1.5 Legal restrictions prevent the Bazista platform from participating in ICO for persons (including legal entities) being citizens/residents of the United States of America, China, Singapore and Hong Kong, and for citizens/residents of countries where the turnover of cryptocurrencies and other digital assets is prohibited (Vietnam, Kirghizia, Taiwan, etc.)

2. Bazista

2.1 BZS is an internal token of the Bazista trading platform that will be available to its users. The funds collected during ICO will be used for developing the platform, bringing in clients, further developing the platform, and for providing favourable terms of BZS token use in exchange and other transactions. The value of BZS tokens is entirely conditional upon development of the Bazista platform, and the digital asset market.

2.2 ICO members that purchase BZS tokens will not become company members (shareholders in the company) and therefore they are not entitled to participate in taking decisions relating to the company's operating activity.

3. Primary Depositing of Tokens (ICO)

3.1 Participating in ICO and purchasing BZS tokens is allowed with the use of Ethereum and other available digital assets (detailed information is available on www.Bazista.io). BZS exchange rate: 1 ETH = 11,000 BZS. Exchange rate of 1 BZS to other digital assets available for BZS purchase will be conditional upon the ETH exchange rate on the date of purchase.

3.2. A total of 440,000,000 BZS will be deposited, of which 13,200,000 BZS will be distributed during Pre-ICO that will start on 16 November 2017 at 12:00 (GMT +3) and will continue till 21 November 2017 at 12:00 (GMT +3). During this time, BZS tokens can be purchased on the platform website, www.Bazista.io. The main round of ICO is scheduled for 4 December 2017.

3.3 If an ICO participant fails to provide or confirm information necessary for buying BZS tokens until the ICO round is completed, all payments earlier made by that participant will be refunded.

3.4 BZS tokens will be given to ICO participants within 21 days after its completion.

3.5 The funds collected from ICO will be distributed in a manner as follows:

55% of the funds will be spent on developing the platform;

35% is the marketing budget;

10% will cover administrative expenses, legal support and other expenses associated with the Bazista trading platform

4. Liability

4.1. Bazista shall not be liable for:

- Any lost profit, lost savings or incidental, special or indirect losses arising out of use or impossibility of using services or products offered by the Bazista platform, or for breach of any of the stated conditions by a third party;
- Any security risk, such as hacker attacks, loss of password, unauthorised access, etc.;
- Any damages resulted from BZS tokens volatility when traded on the exchange.

5. Risks

5.1. Risks are inherent in the Bazista platform participation in ICO and any purchase of BZS tokens. Prior to participating please take a close look at the list of risks stated below, and if necessary, consult a lawyer, accountant, tax or other advisors.

5.2 Holders of BZS tokens should understand that even if sufficient funds are raised (a minimum threshold for ICO is 4,500 ETH) for launching the platform and holding a marketing campaign, the project cannot break even for which reason the price of BZS tokens on the exchange will be below the initial price at the time of ICO.

5.3 The projects funded with the use of ICO remain the subject of regulatory control by different regulatory authorities around the world. In the future, the activity of the Bazista platform can be affected by statutory regulations of the Republic of Estonia (project jurisdiction) that can limit the platform operation.

5.4 Digital cryptography is a new field and therefore there is a risk of unforeseen hacker or any other attacks that can result in loss of BZS tokens kept in one or more wallets.

6. Guarantees

6.1 By purchasing BZS tokens (during or after ICO) you guarantee and confirm that:

- you have a basic knowledge of how to use digital assets and other blockchain-based software systems;
- you are over 18;
- use of BZS tokens is not statutorily prohibited in your jurisdiction;
- you will not use BZS tokens in transactions prohibited by the laws of your country;
- you are a citizen of the USA, China, Singapore, Hong Kong or other countries where access to the digital asset market is limited

7. Privacy Policy

7.1 No Bazista trading platform will receive, process or transfer personal data outside the trading platform. No information provided during the verification process on the Bazista platform will be available to other platform members.

7.2. Prior to participating in ICO you must provide your personal data (your given name, surname, contact details, date of birth, personal identification number, residency, information on a bank account, etc.) for identification purposes.

7.3 By becoming a participant in the Bazista trading platform, you agree to any requests for identity verification and/or protection against fraud as developers can think fit.

Appendix 1

This Appendix sets out a list of goods and services prohibited for sale/offer/exchange and search on the Bazista platform.

1. Precious and rare earth metals, precious stones, and waste containing precious and rare earth metals, and precious stones.
2. Armaments and related supplies, military equipment, spare parts, components and related devices, explosives, blasting supplies, low explosives, all types of missile fuel,

and special materials and special equipment for their production, special-purpose equipment for the staff of paramilitary organizations, and standards and technical documentation for their production and operation.

3. Rocket and space complexes, control and communications systems designed for military use, and standards and technical documentation for their production and operation.

4. Chemical warfare agents, related means of protection, standards and technical documentation for their production and use.

5. Radioactive substances and isotopes, uranium and other related fissile materials and products.

6. X-ray equipment, devices and equipment with the use of radioactive substances and isotopes.

7. Results of research and project activities, and fundamental exploratory research aimed to create armaments and military equipment.

8. Ciphering equipment, standards and technical documentation for its production and use.

9. Poisons, narcotics and psychotropic substances, their precursors; mind-altering substances.

10. Ethyl alcohol, alcohol drinks.

11. Radioactive waste.

12. Explosive waste.

13. Pharmaceuticals (including therapeutic clothing, health food, etc.); medicinal herbs; bioactive additives, including sport nutrition, isotonic beverages, weight loss products (green coffee, Reishi mushrooms, phytoteas, dietary supplements, etc.); vitamins; medical products; medical equipment; contact lenses and liquid for their storage; botox products.

14. Medical services, including massage, services of nutrition specialists, mental physicians, psychotherapists, cosmetic injections, etc.

15. Drugs received as a result of northern reindeer breeding (velvet antlers and endocrine material).
16. Goods whose turnover infringes intellectual rights of third parties (including patents, trademarks, copyright, etc.). The list of prohibited goods also sets out goods that include software replaced (e.g. repeated firmware upgrade) and those affected by malfunction of technical protection tools incorporated by a copyright holder into various devices.
17. Counterfeit or stolen products, or property.
18. Services and/or work of intimate/erotic/sexual nature, and obscene/erotic materials, including sex toys.
19. Counterfeit banknotes and counterfeit postage stamps.
20. Radioelectronic and special technical devices intended for secret obtaining of information.
21. Databases, including those containing personal data that can facilitate unauthorised mailing.
22. Securities (shares, bonds, cheques, etc.), except for securities for collection purposes, with expired term expressly indicated, and/or note of invalidity/cancellation/redemption.
23. Materials and services that violate privacy, infringe on the honour, dignity or business reputation of citizens and legal entities, and relate to state, bank, commercial and other secrets.
24. Materials delivered virtually only and not recorded in any tangible medium (ideas, methods, principles, etc.).
25. Tobacco, tobacco goods, tobacco products, smoking accessories (except for lighters and ashtrays), including pipes, hookahs (including electronic ones), cigarette paper, electronic cigarettes and related consumables.
26. Any weapon, including hunting weapon (including hunting knives), air gun, civilian weapon, airsoft gun, paintball gun, etc., and related components, copies of collectors' weapon, commemorative and decorative weapon, knives (except for kitchen, box-cutting and stationery knives).

27. Human organs and tissues, and donor services (e.g. donating/buying blood/sperm, etc.).
28. Extremist materials; materials calling to mass disorders, terrorist or extremist activity, to participate in mass public events, or create ethnic or sectarian discord.
29. Any financial services, including insurance, and assistance in receipt of the same, financial intermediation.
30. Hootch stills, rectifiers, rectifying columns (other than those for industrial use), Liebig's apparatuses, etc.
31. Transcendent services (witchcraft, magic, alternative medicine, etc.).
32. Services associated with replacing licensed software or malfunctioning technical protection tools incorporated by a copyright holder into phones, smart phones, laptops, navigators, PCs, etc. (including firmware upgrade, unlock, jailbreak, etc.).
33. Surrogate mother's services (search and supply).
34. Services, activities, and materials associated with military service and paramilitary activity in foreign states.
